FOR RESIDENTS OF THE NEW MUNICIPALITY OF SOUTHERN VICTORIA

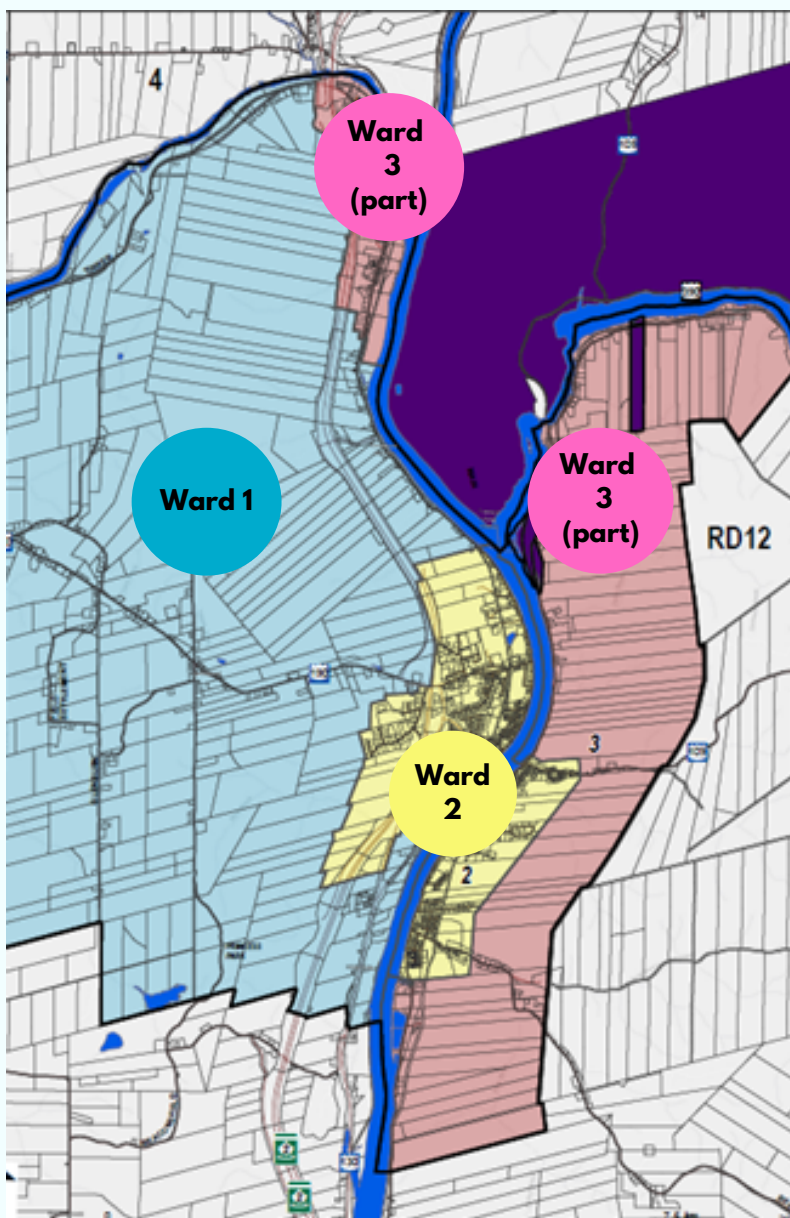
What Election?

There will be a municipal election on Nov 28th, 2022, for mayor and council for the newly formed municipality of SOUTHERN VICTORIA.

What is Southern Victoria?

Southern Victoria is the new name for the restructured municipality. It includes the villages of Perth-Andover and Aroostook, along with some LSD areas including Carlingford, Tinker, Tobique Narrows, Hillandale, and some other areas. (It does not include the entire local school catchment area.)

How many people will be on the new council?

One mayor plus six councillors.

Will people vote for their top 6 councillor candidates as in previous elections?

No, this time there is a “hybrid ward” system with wards and at-large representation.

What difference does the ward make when I vote?

It determines which & how many councillors you vote for. Everybody lives in Ward 1, 2, or 3.

Why does Ward 2 get 3 councillors and the other two wards get only 1 each?

The provincial government wants each councillor to represent approximately the same number of people, and there are 3x as many people living in Ward 2 as in each of the other wards.

Who is running in Southern Victoria for mayor, for my ward, and at large?

Nominations are open until Oct 28th at 2pm. The final slate will be available after that.

What if I want to run for council?

Great! It is important that well-informed community-minded people run for council so that voters have good options. File your papers ASAP! Nominations close Fri Oct 28th at 2pm. You need to live in the ward you hope to represent. If you run for mayor or councillor-at-large, you may live anywhere in Southern Victoria.

Where is the local Returning Office?

The local Returning Office is at Negotkuk Truck Stop. Hours are Monday-Friday 9am-7pm, Saturday 10am-5pm, and closed Sunday.

Where do I vote?

You will receive a voter card in the mail in November telling you where to vote. It should also tell you about advance polls (Nov 19 and 21) and special ballot options.
